2015 Municipal Election Calendar

<u>July 1</u> :	Municipal Election Nomination Papers available at Election Commission office.
<u>July 31</u> :	5 p.m. deadline to submit nomination papers & statements of financial interest for candidates.
August 14:	5 p.m. deadline for Election Commission to certify signatures on nomination papers.
August 18:	5 p.m. deadline for municipal candidates to file withdrawal of nomination.
<u>October 14</u> :	8 p.m. deadline to register to vote in municipal election. In person registration hours are 8:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. Election Commission office only. (Mail-in registration must be postmarked by October 14 th).
<u>October 26</u> :	Deadline for <u>School Committee</u> candidates and <u>Political Committees</u> to file Municipal Campaign & Political Finance Reports. (<u>City Council</u> candidates should consult their OCPF packets regarding depository-filing requirements).
October 30:	Friday. Election Commission will be open 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. for over-the-counter absentee voting.
October 31:	Saturday. Election Commission office will be open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. for over-the-counter absentee voting.
November 2:	Noontime (12 p.m.) deadline to apply for absentee ballot, either for mail-in or over-the-counter voting.

 <u>November 3</u>: Municipal Election. Polls are open 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. All absentee ballots (except Overseas Absentee Ballots) must arrive at the Election Commission office by 8 p.m. to be counted. Ballot count begins at Senior Center, 806 Massachusetts Avenue, Central Square after the polls close. Overseas Absentee Ballots are due by 5 p.m. on Friday, November 13th, but must be postmarked by November 3rd.

November 4: 9am – 5pm. Ballot count resumes at Senior Center, 806 Massachusetts Avenue, Central Square.

November 13: Overseas Absentee Ballots and Provisional Ballots will be counted at 5 p.m.
