

When do City after-school programs start?

After-School Programs

At Fletcher-Maynard, M.L. King, Jr., Morse and Peabody Schools

Begin Tuesday, September 8, 2015

After-school Programs provide four hours of afterschool programming five days a week in four elementary schools (see above list). Programs, also offered during vacation weeks and on snow days, serve children 4.5-11 years old. Some children may be bussed from one school to another.

Community Schools

At Amigos, Fletcher-Maynard, Longfellow (music lessons) and Morse Schools

Begin Monday, September 14, 2015

At All Other Schools

Begin Monday, September 21, 2015

Community Schools provides afterschool enrichment programs at twelve elementary schools. Parents register their 4.5-11 year olds for each enrichment class at the start of the school year. Programs begin at the sites' school dismissal time and end between 5:30 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Some children may be bussed from one school to another.

Cambridge Youth Programs (CYP)

At Area IV, Frisoli, Gately and Russell Youth Centers

Begin Tuesday, September 8, 2015

CYP provides after-school programming for children Grades 4-8 in four state-of-the-art Youth Centers (see above list). Programming runs between 2:00 and 6:00 p.m. Applications are accepted from August 7th on a rolling basis until all slots are filled. Children, who are eligible to be bussed from home, may choose to be dropped off at a CPS bus stop at or near a Youth Center.
