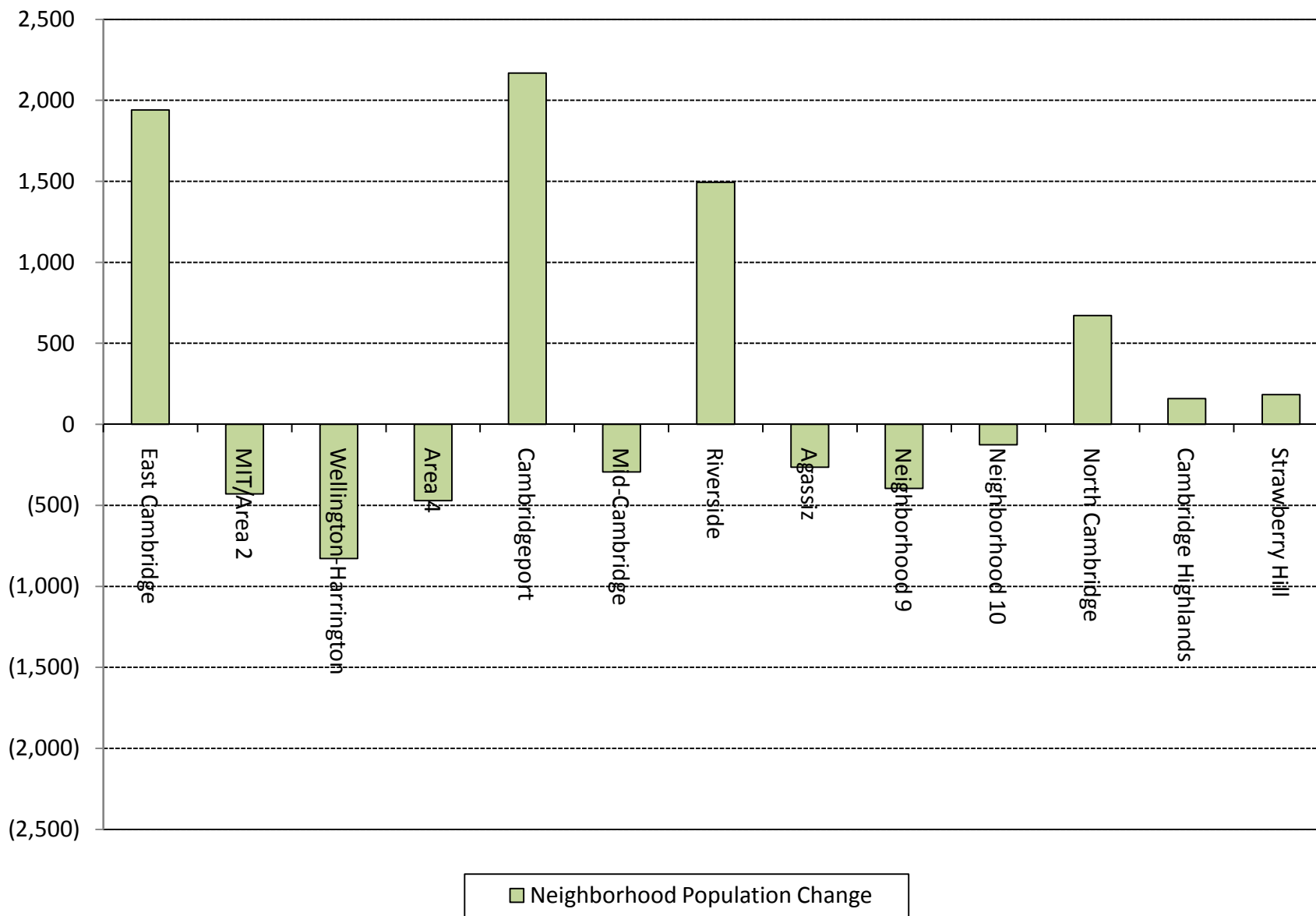
1. The category "Some Other Race" indicates that the respondent wrote in a race category not included elsewhere by the Census Bureau. Examples of responses coded as "Some Other Race" include various Hispanic groups, multiracial, mixed, Cajun, Cape Verdean and Creole.
2. Census 2000 was the first census to allow respondents to report more than one race for an individual. Responses in this table indicate whether a respondent selected a single race category "alone" or two or more race categories.
3. Hispanic status is independent of race and reflects whether a respondent has origins in either Spain or the Spanish speaking countries of the western hemisphere. The later include Mexico, Cuba and the Dominican Republic, as well as all Spanish speaking countries located in Central America and South America.
4. Due to the requirements of Census Geography, a small portion of the population in Strawberry Hill, located along Grove Street, is allocated to Cambridge Highlands.
5. The Asian/Pacific category combines the Asian category and the Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander category.
