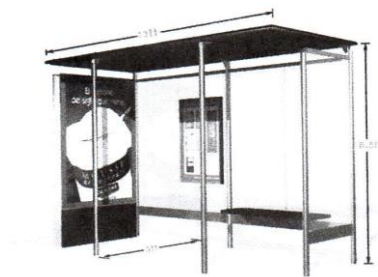
RE: MBTA Bus Shelter Program
