The existing Floor Area Ratio (FAR) is .75 and would become .5/.35; the lot area required per dwelling is now 1,500 square feet and would become 2,500/4,000 square feet; the open space requirement is now 30% and would become 40%. Allowed uses now include single, two family, townhouse and multifamily dwellings; the Residence B district allowed uses are single, two family and townhouse dwellings.
