Program Updates:

It is wonderful that we can now take advantage of the weather and get outside as much as possible now that spring is here. The children have enjoyed exploring many of the neighborhood parks.

A.M. Drop-Off

I think we thought that once the snow disappeared our parking issues would also go away. NO SUCH LUCK! Parking and traffic continue to be a nightmare! Then you add street cleaning to the equation and it gets even worse. I do have to remind you that our arrival cut off before you are considered late is 9:30. The above mentioned issues will not go away. Please make sure you leave enough time to deal with these difficulties in order to arrive before 9:30. We serve breakfast from 8:30 to 9:20 if it makes it easier for you, have your child eat at school. Earlier arrival also gives your child more time to come into school and get acclimated before we move on to structured activities.

P.M. Pick-up

 Most afternoons we will be outside in the school playground for pick-up. We are no longer bringing out the children's belongings. It is too difficult to keep track of what goes home, what stays, and some of the children have so much to carry that teachers are not able to carry things for themselves. Teachers have program materials they are required to carry with them at all times.

I am suggesting that when you arrive to pick-up your child you get their belongings before you get them. Often the children want to play and you want to give them that time, which can be a wonderful time to watch them and enjoy their abilities. Then it comes time to leave and it is hard to get them to go in and get their things.

- On the housekeeping side of things, once 5:30 comes and all the children have been picked up the teachers need to lock the classrooms before they leave. While we do have Moisena, our cleaning woman, here we cannot have her feel responsible for letting families in and out of the classroom.
- Once you have entered the playground to pick-up your child it can be tricky to know who is responsible for your child, you or the teachers. We are asking you to assist the teachers by taking responsibility of your child so that they can take care of the children who have not been picked up yet. We are also asking you to support the teachers by having your child continue to follow school rules. If you have any questions regarding these rules the teachers would be happy to answer your questions.

Next week we will be handing out Family Surveys. I will be setting up a table near the office where you can fill out your survey and put it into a box to ensure confidentiality. Please check off your name once you have completed the survey. It is my intent to have everyone fill out the surveys at drop-off or pick-up rather than send them home. I am hoping for 100% participation. We use your feedback for program improvements. We also share the results with our

administration in order to ask for support or to show off what we do well. So it is very important for you to participate. If you need to take it home with you or need someone to interpret the questions, please let us know.
