

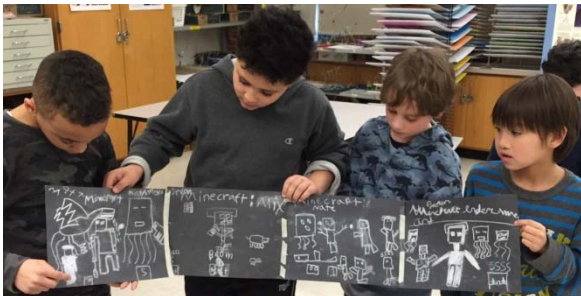
Dear Peabody 2-5 Families,
