Field permits are required for use of any City of Cambridge athletic fields. *(For non-athletic use of city fields please contact the Department of Public Works at 617-349-4846.)*

Permit requests can be submitted to the Recreation Division starting the first week of February. The fee for adult use only is \$120.00 per two hour increment.

Cambridge youth programs have priority of use and are not charged permit fees.
