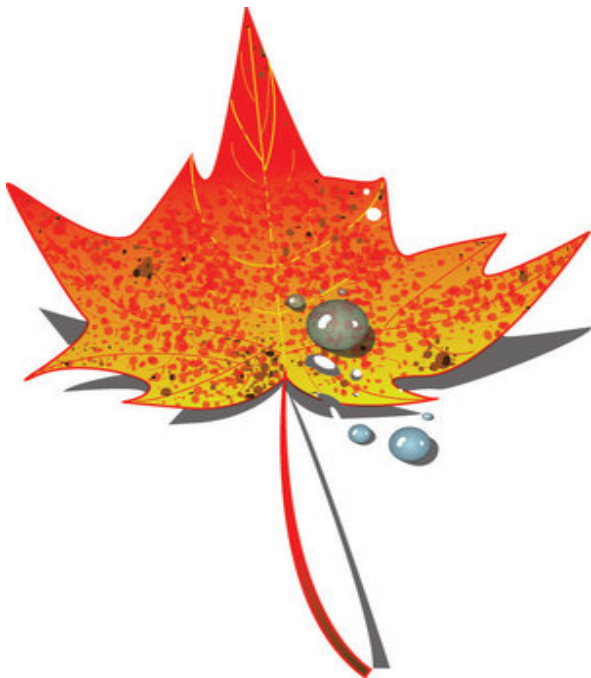

GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION & POLICIES

The Elm Street Community School is a community-based program that focuses on programs/activities and special community events for school-age children to active older adults. We welcome community involvement and suggestions to help provide services to the neighborhood in our efforts to develop a strong community based program. Council meetings will be held regularly for neighborhood residents to attend. For additional information about these meetings contact the Director.

Registration Procedure

Our Fall Session will begin on Monday, September 18th and will end on Friday, February 16th. Registration will begin Tuesday, September 13th from 5:00 P.M. - 6:30 P.M. in the school's Cafeteria. When your name is called you will simply drop off the registration forms with payment and you can leave. Registration continues on Tuesday from 7:30 - 9 A.M. After these dates please drop off your child's registration form in the Community Schools Mail Box in the main office. Class selection will be based on available spaces. For more information call 617/349-6307. If you cannot come to register at the times listed above because of a prior commitment, please contact the Community School Director at 617-349-6307. Our classes must have a minimum of 6 participants or the class will be cancelled.

Please Note: An Annual Application Fee of \$25.00 per child is required at registration. (This fee is applicable for the School Year only).

PAYMENTS

Full payment is due at time of registration, however a payment plan can be arranged with the director. Checks or Money Orders (NO CASH) should be made payable to: Elm Street Community School. If you have an outstanding balance with any Department of Human Service Program, your child's registration will not be accepted until all payments are made. Class fees are based on the number of weeks a class meets. **Returned checks** will be charged an additional \$25.00. Full payment must be made within 48 hours to avoid disruption in your child's schedule.

REFUNDS

If a class is not fully enrolled, the class may be cancelled. You will be notified and given a refund, or an alternative class may be chosen. We understand that there may be times when a class is not what your child expected. A full refund will be given if we are notified within 24 hours after the first class. Partial refunds will only be given if a child is no longer able to participate due to medical reasons. Refunds are not issued for missed classes.

EARLY RELEASE DAYS

Regular scheduled classes are **not** held on early release days. A special activity or field trip will be planned. Children must be pre-registered during the September registration dates to attend any early release day trips. Registration for Early Release Day Activities are only for current registered Community School participants.

PROGRAM CLOSINGS

Classes are not held on city holidays, snow days or on days the Cambridge Public Schools are closed.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Partial scholarships are available to families who qualify. Please request a financial aid form from the director. Income verification in the form of W – 2 or 4 current pay stubs must be submitted with the application. All information provided will be kept confidential. Deadline for financial assistance is Friday, September 15th.

CHILD PICK UP & ABSENCES

Children will only be released to those you have authorized on your child's registration / emergency card. If there is any change in pick up arrangements the director must be notified in advance. Only children ages 9 & up will be allowed to walk home with parent/guardian permission. Please notify us by phone or email if your child will be absent from the program.

LATE FEE POLICY

Instructors are not responsible for children after the class ending time. All children must be promptly picked up at the end of class. There will be a late fee of \$1.00 per minute for each minute you are late after the scheduled pick up time. Late fees must be paid within 48 hours to avoid disrupting your child's participation in the program. Chronic lateness may result in suspension of your child's participation in the program.

SCHOLARSHIP DRIVE

We welcome your contribution to assist us with providing scholarships to families in financial need. You may choose to support a particular program or contribute to our general scholarship fund. We thank you for your support.

EQUAL ACCESS

INCLUSION POLICY

Department of Human Service Programs welcomes individuals with disabilities in all of its Out of School Time Programs. DHSP will provide reasonable accommodations to individuals with disabilities who meet the basic eligibility requirements of the OST Programs or who with the provision of reasonable accommodations will be able to meet the basic eligibility requirements to facilitate equal participation for those individuals in existing OST Programs.

Community Schools Bus Policy

The Community School Programs offer afterschool enrichment classes in every elementary school in Cambridge. Most children attend the classes at the Community School located in their school building. Some families prefer to have their children attend classes in the school building located in their neighborhood. If an established bus route exists from a child's school to the preferred Community School, very often the Cambridge Public Schools are able to transport children to that Community School. Parents/guardians need to make transportation arrangements with the Cambridge Public Schools.

In an effort to support families, beginning this year a staff person from Community Schools will be available in front of the school to greet children under the age of 9 arriving by bus and will escort them into the school. Children age 9 and older who have parental permission may enter the school on their own.

To avoid disrupting ongoing classes and to support children's full participation in the enrichment classes, children must arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the start of Community School Program and no later than 1 hour past the program start time. 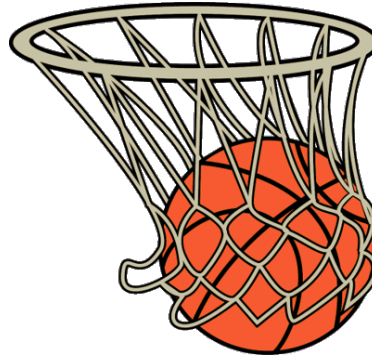

The 2nd half of the session will lead into; **Writing Wizards:** In Writing Wizards, we foster a love of writing by guiding students to write and publish their own real book! Using novels like Harry Potter and The Chronicles of Narnia as inspiration, each class designs a fantasy world that includes major and minor characters, fantastic settings, an extended backstory and a world of wonder. The authors use artwork and brainstorming to design plot twists and dynamic characters. Teachers guide the students, providing contextual mini-lessons on writing techniques that include the use of appropriate dialogue, detailed descriptions, sensory-rich word choice, and character, plot and theme development. At the end of the course, students publish their first real novel—signed by our Writing Wizards!

Expert Architects: The sky is the limit in this math, writing and presentation class, our students find out on the first day of class that they are the heads of the city's newest architectural firm. They are commissioned with building the tallest building in a nearby city and must plan their design. Students learn a kid-friendly history of skyscrapers and create a blueprint of their own stylized tall building. They then must weigh other considerations including environmental effects, traffic and surrounding buildings using Google Earth to find the perfect location for their project. Once their blueprint is finished, our expert architects create a three-dimensional model of the structure and deliver a presentation to their "clients" highlighting all aspects of their creation. In the second half of the session the students will begin **Future House**

What will life on Earth be like a century from now? In our *Future House* class, students imagine and design their home in the year 2117. First, they study what daily life was like one hundred years ago and then they consider how life might change one hundred years in the future. They study the writings of futurists, learn about new "smart homes" and consider what phones, stoves, sofas, televisions and cars might look like in one hundred years. Students use math, writing and presentation skills as they draw up an extensive blueprint of their future house, write a "Day in the Life" story about 2117 and work with geometric calculations as they design their blueprint. Time travel may not really be possible but our *Future House* students will find themselves in a different time and place!
