FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: Partial scholarships are available to families who qualify. Please request a financial aid form from the director. Income verification in the form of W-2 or 4 current pay stubs must be submitted with the application. All information provided will be kept confidential. Deadline for financial assistance is Thursday January 8, 2015.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE: Registration is held on Tuesday, January 6th, Wednesday January 7th & Thursday January 8, 2015. Registration for all programs will be on a first-come, first-served basis in the Community School Office @ Peabody School Café'. **Full payment** is required when you register.

NOTE: There will be a \$25.00 registration fee per child for the school year. Registration will not be held on Monday January 12 (1st day of classes).

PAYMENTS: Full payment is due at the time of registration unless a payment plan is arranged with the director. Checks should be made payable to: **Fitzgerald Community School**.

*Returned checks will be charged an additional \$25.00. Full payment must be received within 48 hours to avoid disrupting your child's program schedule.

If you have any outstanding balances due with any Department of Human Service Program your child may not register until all payments are up to date.

REFUNDS: If a class does not fill, the class may have to be cancelled. This is a rare occurrence, but if it should happen you will be notified and given a full refund, with the opportunity to enroll in another class. We understand that there may be times when a class is not what your child expected. Refunds will be given only if we are notified within 24 hours of the first class your child attended. Exceptions for medical issues, documentation required.

SCHOLARSHIP DRIVE: We welcome your contribution to assist us with providing scholarships to families in financial need. You may choose to support a particular program or contribute to our general scholarship fund. We thank you for your support.

EARLY RELEASE DAYS: Regular scheduled classes are not held on early release days. A special activity or field trip will be planned. Watch for flyers the week before, they will be distributed to all students. Class fees are set on the number of times a class actually meets. Therefore early release days and holidays, when there are no scheduled classes, have been taken into account and fees have been set accordingly.

HOLIDAYS AND SNOW DAYS: Classes are not held on snow days, school holidays or any other days there is no school for the Cambridge Public Schools.

WINTER SESSION: Classes have been scheduled to begin the week of Monday January 12, 2015 and end the week of Friday April 17, 2015.

LATE FEE POLICY: All children must be promptly picked up at the end of class. A \$1.00 late fee is assessed for a late pick-up for every minute or any fraction thereof starting 5 minutes after the class ends. Late fees must be paid within 48 hours of the week.

Excessive late pick-up or failure to pay late fees may result in suspension of services.

TRANSPORTATION: Community Schools does not provide transportation from school to after school programming. We do not meet children at school bus stops. Only children ages 9 & up, with parent permission, may ride the bus from another school and walk into the program.
