## Registration Procedures

- **Our formal application period for enrichment classes will be Friday, April 4 through Wednesday, April 16th.** There is a
  \$25 registration fee per child per academic year. You may register in
  the Community School office, room 018 between 10:00am—12:30pm
  or 1:30pm 5:30pm, Monday- Friday. Registrations are accepted on
  a first-come, first-served basis. After the registration period ends,
  registration is ongoing if space permits. The registration form included
  in this brochure must be completed and brought to the Community
  School Office along with additional forms listed below.
- The following is required for all applicants:
  - o Community School registration form
  - o Community School Enrichment Class Selection form
  - o IEP release and consent form
  - o Payment is due at registration (min \$50 deposit)
  - o DHSP application for enrollment
    - o Emergency card
    - o Annual Registration Fee \$25

## Program Fees and Payment Policy

- The fee for unlimited classes is \$225.00 (plus equipment feesas noted for some classes) per session (Monday-Friday until 5:30)

- For full-time enrollement a \$50 deposit is due to reserve

## Arrival Policy

Fletcher Maynard Community School cannot be responsible for children arriving to our program before 3:45pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays or Fridays. **We will greet children at the FMA official dismissal times**.

## Pick-up / Sign-out Policy

All children must be promptly picked up at the end of class. Please sign your child out when you arrive to verify that they have been picked up. For the safety of your child please indicate on your registration form who will be picking up your child. Please wait for the instructor to dismiss your child to avoid interrupting a class.

## Late Fee Policy

A \$1 per minute late fee will be assessed for pickups after the program ends. Time will be measured by the classroom clock. We require late fees to be paid within 48 hours.

Excessive late pick-up may result in suspension of services.

## Homework Center Policy

We provide 45 minute or 1 hour Homework Centers 4 days a week as part of our class listings where children are provided with a quiet environment and supplies to get their homework started. Staff is available to answer simple questions; however we cannot offer 1 on 1 tutoring at this time. If you wish to have your child participate in Homework Center, please indicate this on the class choice form. The Fletcher Maynard Community School does not guarantee that all homework will be completed.

## Snacks

We provide a 10 minute snack time at 4:35pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays & Fridays. On Wednesdays our snack time is at 3:10 pm and runs for 15 minutes. Each day 1 piece of fruit per child is provided for snack; if your child gets extra hungry or doesn't like fruit, please send an extra snack for him/her to eat specifically at this time. If your child has any food allergies or restrictions, please provide a snack for your child daily and specify restrictions on your application form so that we can keep all children healthy and safe.

## Holidays and Snow Days

Classes are not held on snow days, school holidays or any other day there is no school for the Cambridge Public Schools.

## Early Release Days

FMA Students are released at 2:00pm each Wednesday.

The Fletcher Maynard Community School will run early release day activities on Wednesday, May 14 12:00pm- 5:30pm. These activities require advance registration, at an additional cost of \$30.00 per trip. Limited scholarships are available to qualifying families.
