The Preschool Program consists of a classroom under the direction of the Head Teacher, Teacher, and Classroom Assistants. Your child will participate in many activities such as: summer reading, arts & crafts, storytelling, sprinkler & wading pool, games, performances, field trips, beginner math skills, nap time and other leisure time activities.

DAY CAMP FOR 4.5 – 13 YEAR OLDS
MONDAY – FRIDAY, 8:00am – 3:30pm

Our program consists of 4 classrooms (4 - 5 yrs., 6 - 7 yrs. 8-9 yrs., 10-13 yrs.) Under the direction of the Head Teacher, Teacher, and Classroom Assistants. Children are divided into separate age groups to allow them to participate in age appropriate activities such as: arts & crafts, tennis lessons, gardening, soccer, summer reading, weekly field trips, stage performances, swimming lessons, bowling, fun math games, music and other leisure and recreational activities.

4.5 – 13 YEAR OLDS

Children will participate in all morning activities. Additional activities will be planned for the extended day hours to include free swim and local playgrounds.

Our camp qualified for the 2017 Summer Food Program. We will reapply for summer 2018, and let families know whether lunches will be provided or sent from home.
