Licensing

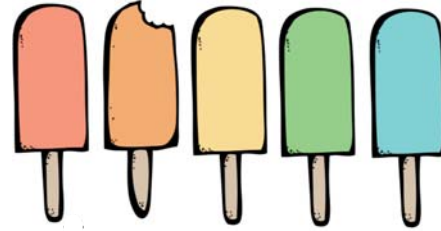

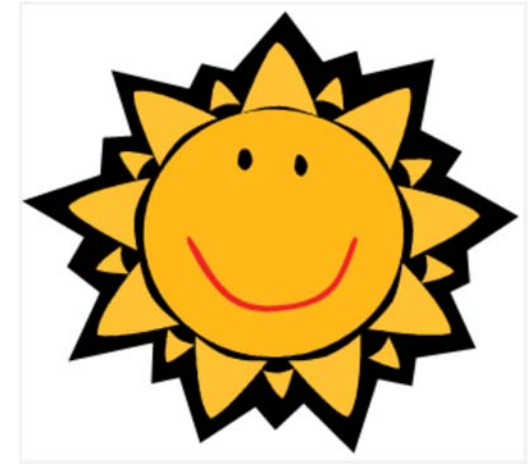

ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

Tobin Kids Camp will provide your child with a summer of excitement and adventure in a safe and caring environment. Values, Respect, Fairness and Acceptance are part of our philosophy. We recognize and encourage each child's uniqueness. Your child will participate in a supervised, structured yet flexible program where children have the opportunity to develop special relationships with staff and peers.

Through weekly themes we provide campers the opportunity to experience science, music, the arts, sports, technology and cooking. Additionally they will enjoy being outdoors in the park, fresh pond and water play in the sprinklers. Our staff to child ratio insures that your child will receive the individual attention they need.

Pre-School Group – 2.9 to 4 Years

Our pre-school program offers a fun, safe, loving environment which enables children to explore and learn through creative art and play. Our program is designed to promote social skills such as sharing, cooperating, and respect while developing listening skills and becoming independent learners. Children will participate in daily art, music, literacy, sports and dramatic arts with daily park and water play opportunities. A few local field trips will enhance your child's summer camp experience. **(Children must be toilet trained)**

School Age Groups – Ages 4 to 10 Years

School age campers will venture out once or twice a week on field trips. Beach trips and trips to zoo's, museums, and other fun destinations will enhance our weekly themes. Campers will also be provided the opportunity to participate in weekly drama, music, dance, swim & gymnastics lessons with highly trained instructors. **(Children must 4 years old by 3/31/18)**

Extended Day Program

The extended day program runs until 5:30 and is a more relaxed atmosphere. Children have had a busy day already, so our extended day staff provides a more informal environment with quiet games, crafts, and playground time. All children are offered a rest period after lunch. Children will receive an additional snack once the extended day program begins.

Each of our age groups will be staffed with a Head Counselor, Asst. Counselor, and junior counselors. Some of our staff have been with us for many years and have an extensive background in working with children during the school year as teachers and assistant teachers. Our specialists for are highly trained in their area of expertise. Certified lifeguards will accompany us on all water trips. Each of our lead staff is certified in first aid and CPR by the American Heart Association. All staff have received additional training in many areas of child development and curriculum planning.

Lunch and Snack

A healthy morning and afternoon snack will be provided for all children. Children must bring a daily bag lunch. Refrigeration is provided for lunches.
