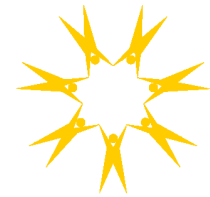

CYP has six exciting summer programs for your child!

The **Mission Possible: Solve it!** @**Moore Youth Center** is for rising 6th, 7th, 8th graders offered in collaboration with Cambridge Public Schools at Putnam Avenue Upper School and the Moore Youth Center. We will start the program a week before the CPSD programs and continue a week after. Our day will begin at PAUS where students will spend their mornings with CPS math teachers exploring math concepts and skills in an interactive program with lots of personal attention from CPS and DHSP staff. Afternoons will consist of: lunch followed by hands on interactive, fun activities to develop leadership and pre-workforce skills, experiential learning, exploring local college campuses, identifying interesting ways people use math in every life and at work.

The **Discovery Program** @ **Russell Youth Center** is for rising 4th-8th graders will take place in our state-of-the art facility and provide opportunities for youth to develop a wide range of interests and to express themselves through performing and visual arts, science exploration, sports and other fun activities. Youth participate in a variety of classes that are designed for all skill levels and focus on mastery of new skills.

The **Girls' Empowerment Program** @ **Frisoli Youth Center** is for rising 4th-8th graders young women to explore a host of enriching activities including volleyball, self-defense, tennis, swimming, arts, science and other academic areas, field trips and more. The curriculum is designed to build the confidence and self-esteem of the young women in the program and build community.



The **Boys' Empowerment Program** @ **Frisoli Youth Center** is an exciting pilot program, in conjunction with the Girls Empowerment Program, for rising 4th-8th graders who will have the opportunity to explore similar topics and experiences as the Girls' Program but with the focus of our young men. The young men will be engaged in enriching curriculum, activities and field trips that will support the development of identity, self-esteem and confidence in themselves and the importance of building community.

The **Gately Summer Program** Designed especially for youth entering 6th, 7th or 8th grades. (There are a limited # of spaces for currently enrolled Gately Members who are rising 5th graders). The program offers a variety of fun and enriching activities ranging from sports and arts instruction to creating and teaching workshops to peers and younger youth. Healthy living and leadership development are central themes in the curriculum.

The **Sports Leadership Academy** @the newly named **Moses Youth Center (formerly Area IV)** is for rising 4th-8th graders, boys and girls interested in learning, practicing, and playing sports for the summer. Each young person will be involved in soccer, basketball, swimming, tennis, and more. The daily schedule is a physically active combination of fitness activities with specific sports instruction and competition. While the emphasis is on athletics, activities will also focus on enrichment, academic, leadership and sportsmanship.
