Families at the Center:

- Expansion of the Door-2-Door Campaign (Cambridge Connects)
- Centralized Resource Website/Portal
- Information Hub(s)
- Q&A and Discussion
 - Very impressive work
 - Particularly excited for Centralized Resource Website/Portal
 - With the Centralized Resource Website/Portal:
 - Is the first project going to be moving the resource guide over or is there the chance to have community create content ala the ted talk?
 - It would be nice to include people in the process
 - Ideally translated into the many languages people speak
 - With the Door-2-Door Expansion (Cambridge Connects):
 - Do you know what works well already and what aspects don't work well?
 - We're in the 5th year in Door-2-Door Campaign and have established some significant relationships with people and there is a grown comfort level
 - The expansion includes asking what are the concerns that the people in the specific neighborhoods have rather than just giving them information
 - It will take a lot of prep work. We couldn't have done this two years ago

- Book bike will be in Area 4, which can be a "soft opening" for Cambridge Connects – asking those in the neighborhood these questions
- The projects are connected -- The information gathered from Cambridge Connects will be good for the other two groups to have and Cambridge Connects can use the app that is developed.
