Did you know that the City of Cambridge offers scholarships to eligible Cambridge high school seniors and others pursuing higher education? Thanks to the generous support of many area residents and businesses, the City awarded 45 scholarships of \$2,500 each.

The City Scholarship program is open to all Cambridge residents. In order to be eligible, applicants must be attending, pending an acceptance or have received acceptance to attend an educational institution beyond the high school level prior to the time for payment of the scholarship award. This is a one-time scholarship in an effort to give more eligible applicants an opportunity to receive some financial assistance. Award recipients are selected based on a number of criteria including academic achievement, school and community involvement, work experience, aspirations and goals, financial need, unusual personal circumstances, etc. If you know of a deserving student, please encourage him or her to apply.
