## ELM STREET CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

---

*During the week of July 5, the City's contractor, A.R. Belli, will perform sewer repair work on Elm Street, between Market St and Broadway. During work hours, Elm St from Market St to Broadway will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters.*

### **Project Schedule**

- Crews expect to begin work on Tuesday, July 5 (weather permitting).
- The sewer repair work is expected to take 1 week to complete.
- Work hours are 7 AM to 4 PM, Tuesday through Friday.
- Final roadway paving in this section will take place in late July; an additional paving notice will be distributed once a paving date is confirmed.

### **What to Expect during Construction**

- During work hours, Elm St from Market St to Broadway will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters.
- Pedestrian and vehicle access into properties will be maintained at all times, but may be restricted in certain ways.
- Traffic signs and police details will be in place to assist neighbors.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
- City services will continue uninterrupted.
