ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION
Beginning Thursday, June 9th**

Dear Residents/Business Owners,

Starting as early as **Thursday, June 9th** (weather permitting), Eversource Energy will begin chipping out an existing duct bank on Garden Street (Alpine to Walden), in preparation for full depth roadway reconstruction. Following Eversource's work, the City's contractor, P. Gioioso & Sons, Inc., will be undertaking **roadway reconstruction** of Garden Street (Alpine to Walden). Surface reconstruction includes roadway demolition and base course paving. Final paving and curb & sidewalk reconstruction will occur at a later date, for which you will receive a separate notification.

This combined work is anticipated to take 6-8 weeks to complete, with areas being impacted intermittently during this time.

What to Expect During Surface Reconstruction:

- Construction hours are 7am to 4 pm.
- There will be **No Parking** allowed on the streets between the hours of 7 am and 4 pm. Please pay attention to posted signs.
- Traffic on Garden Street will be detoured between the hours of 7am and 4pm. Signage and/or police details will be onsite to assist traffic.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways of entryways, the contractor will coordinate access directly with residents/businesses.
- Emergency vehicles will have access to all properties at all times.
- City services will continue uninterrupted.
