Huron A - Alewife Sewer Separation Project

Dear Resident,

As part of the ongoing construction of the **Huron A - Alewife Sewer Separation Project**, the City’s contractor, P. Gioioso & Sons, Inc., is scheduled to begin work on Vassal Lane (between Lakeview Avenue and Standish Street) in April. This construction will take approximately 6 months to complete. During portions of this construction period, existing traffic patterns will be modified and access to the Tobin School and Vassal Lane will be restricted to school traffic and abutting residents only.

The City is hosting a Community Meeting to review the upcoming work, the temporary traffic pattern changes and to answer resident’s questions about what to expect during the construction process.
