For **Residential Streets North of Huron Ave**, please join us on **Saturday, August 4<sup>th</sup>** from 9am to 2pm for all or part of the walk. We will cover the neighborhood in the following order:

12:15 PM	Reservoir Street, Walden Street	Intersection of Reservoir St. and Huron Ave
1:00 PM	Appleton Street, Huchinson Street Saville Street, Royal Ave.	Intersection of Walden St. and Saville St.

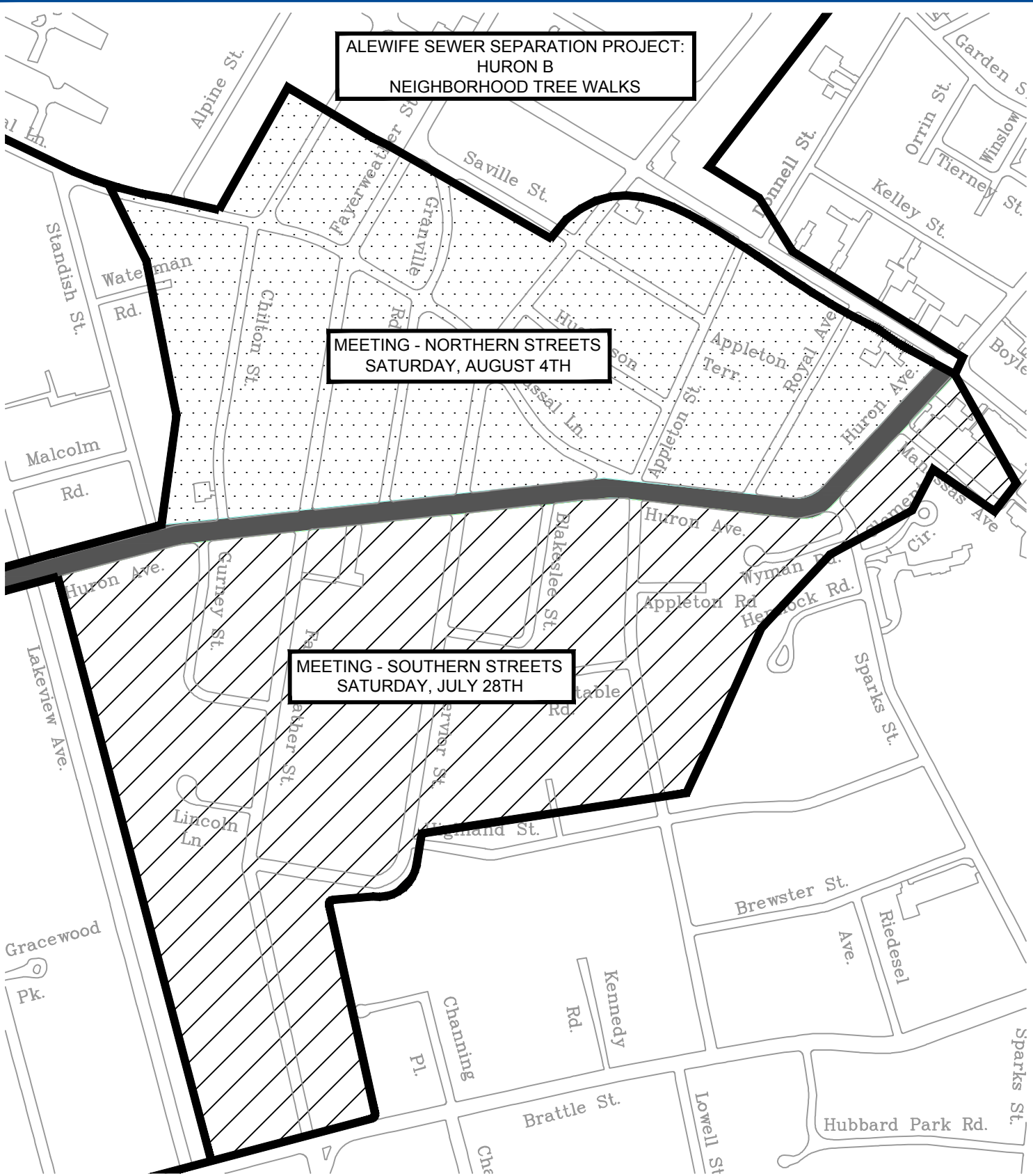
