PROSPECT STREET TO PORTLAND STREET

Sidewalk Materials Survey

The City of Cambridge is proposing to reconstruct the roadway and sidewalks on Broadway between Prospect Street and Portland Street. We can reconstruct the sidewalks with the existing materials, which are a mix of concrete and brick. Or we can implement a more unified approach, which is supported by the City's Disabilities' Commission and Pedestrian Committee – consistent brick edging with a concrete walking surface, as shown in the photos.
