UPLAND ROAD ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION

Raymond St to Huron Ave

As part of ongoing improvements, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corp., will begin reconstructing the surface of the roadway on Upland Rd on *Monday, August 1*, to prepare the street for paving. Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, and Upland Rd will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters.

Crews will mobilize on Upland Rd on Wednesday, July 27 to begin preparing for roadway reconstruction.

What to Expect During Roadway Reconstruction:

- On Monday, August 1, crews will begin on Upland Rd at Raymond St and work their way towards Huron Ave.
- There cannot be any cars parked on the street during this work. Please be sure to check "No Parking" signs to avoid being ticketed and towed.
- Signage and police details will be in place to assist neighbors, but drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes.
- Paving is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, August 4 (weather permitting). An additional notice confirming the paving date will follow.
