

Detour Information Related to Construction of the Raised Intersection at Spring and Fulkerson streets

As part of ongoing improvements, the City's contractor, DeFelice Corp, is continuing construction on the raised intersection at Spring and Fulkerson streets, and on the raised crosswalk on Spring Street at Sixth Street.

- In order to complete the raised intersection, the intersection of Spring and Fulkerson streets will need to be closed to traffic.
- This closure will be in effect starting Thursday, September 20, and will continue on Friday, Saturday & Monday (if necessary).
- Please see the reverse of this notice for detour plan; a more detailed notice related to student drop off at Kennedy-Longfellow is being distributed to students today as well.
- Normal construction work hours will be 7 am to 4 pm on weekdays, and 9 am to 5 pm on Saturdays. However, the intersection will likely need to remain closed to vehicle traffic on a continuous basis until construction is completed.

Pavement markings are also scheduled to be completed later this week along Spring Street. Please be sure to check posted signage for any parking restrictions.
