NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ON MASS AVE

Construction Begins Week of July 14

Dear Mass Ave Neighbor:

On Tuesday, July 15 (weather permitting), the City's contractor, Marchese Construction, will mobilize on Mass Ave between Beech St and Russell St, to begin surface improvements. The scope of work includes reconstructed sidewalks, new roadway paving and street trees. We expect the work to take about 2 months to complete.

Project Schedule

- Crews will first reconstruct the sidewalks on the west (even) side of Mass Ave, between Regent St and Cogswell Ave. We expect this to take about 3-4 weeks to complete.
- Once crews complete the west side, they will move to the east (odd) side, between Blake St and Russell St, which is also expected to take about 3-4 weeks to complete.
- Once the sidewalks are reconstructed, crews will pave the roadway on Mass Ave, from Blake St to Russell St.
- Overall construction is expected to take 2 to complete. We will continue to update neighbors as the work progresses.

What to Expect during Construction

- Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times.
- Pedestrian and vehicle access into properties will be maintained, but may be altered in certain ways.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times; city services will continue uninterrupted.
