## **CONCORD AVE ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION**

*Blanchard Rd to Alewife Brook Rotary*

**NIGHT WORK: Wednesday, September 21, and Thursday, September 22  
8:00 PM to 6:00 AM**

Dear Resident or Business,

On Wednesday, September 21, the City's contractor, C.J. Mabardy, Inc. will begin grinding the existing asphalt on Concord Ave, from Blanchard Rd to the Alewife Brook Rotary in preparation of paving. In order to minimize traffic disruptions, **grinding operations will take place overnight on Wednesday, September 21 and Thursday, September 22, from 8 PM to 6 AM.**

During work hours, vehicle traffic on Concord Ave will be reduced to one lane; outbound traffic (Cambridge to Belmont) will remain open, and inbound traffic (Belmont to Cambridge) will be detoured. Inbound traffic will be detoured right onto Blanchard Rd, left onto Grove St, left onto Huron Ave, and left onto Fresh Pond Parkway to Concord Ave.

**\*Please take special precautions while driving as castings will be raised for the next few weeks.\***
