PLEASANT STREET DRAINAGE WORK

Begins Wednesday, April 8

Dear Neighbor,

In association with the reconstruction of the Pleasant Street/Fairmont Street intersection, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corp., will mobilize to the area on Wednesday, April 8 to perform drainage work. This work is expected to be completed within 2 weeks, weather permitting. The surface work associated with this project is expected to begin in mid-late July 2015.

What to Expect during Construction

- Construction hours will be Monday through Friday, 7am-4pm.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; residents are advised to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
- Emergency vehicles will maintain access at all times and the City's curbside trash and recycling services will continue uninterrupted.
