## TREMONT STREET CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Raised Intersection Construction Begins Tuesday, April 22 (at Gardner Rd)

Dear Tremont Street Neighbor,

On **Tuesday, April 22** (weather permitting), the City's contractor, Marchese Construction, will begin construction of a raised intersection at Tremont St and Gardner Rd. Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM and we expect the work to take 3 weeks to complete.

## Project Schedule

- Crews will mobilize on Tuesday, April 22 and will first install new catch basins at the intersection. We expect this to take 3-4 days to complete.
- Once the drainage is installed, crews will begin constructing the raised intersection at Gardner Rd, which is expected to take about 2 weeks to complete.

## What to Expect during Construction

- Tremont St will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters during work hours.
- There will be times during construction when vehicle access in and out properties is restricted. We will continue to update residents as the work progresses.
- Police details and signs will be in place to assist neighbors.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times. City services will continue uninterrupted.
