It is expressly understood and agreed that the Contract Time is reasonable for the completion of the Work, taking all factors into consideration.	
CONTRACT SUM	
The City will pay the Contractor for performance of the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents the sum of \$ as set forth on the Contractor's bid form.	
The City shall not be liable for any claims or requests for payment by the Contractor which would cause the total claims or payments under this Contract to exceed the amount certified by the City Auditor as being appropriated for this Contract.
