This program offers year round activities to all age groups, including school age enrichment courses, out-of-school time activities, vacation and summer camps, family events, adult courses, and senior trips and activities. The Tobin Neighborhood Council is always seeking new members to help the Community School identify the needs, concerns, and interests of the community. All meetings begin at 5:45 PM. Childcare will be provided.

Classes will begin **January 12<sup>th</sup>** and end **April 17<sup>th</sup>**

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

- The Application form attached to the back of this program AND a DHSP Enrollment Application should be filled out and dropped off during the noted registration times below.
- Additional forms may need to be completed
  - Information release, Emergency card,
- There is annual school year application fee of \$25 per child due at registration.
- Applications must be returned to the Community School Office.
- Applications are taken on a **first come first serve basis**.
- After these dates applications will be accepted on a space available basis.
- You will be notified only if the class you have chosen is full. If you do not hear from us you may assume your child is enrolled in the selected class.
- Children's House classes are only available to 4 & 5 Year olds.
- Children may only apply for classes in their appropriate age group.

### **PAYMENTS:**

Full payment is due at the time of registration, however a payment plan can be arranged with the director. Checks or Money Orders (**NO CASH**) should be made payable to: **Tobin Community School. If you have an outstanding balance with any Department of Human Service Program, your child's application will not be accepted until all payments are made.** Class fees are based on the number of weeks a class meets. Early Release Days and holidays are not counted in the number of classes. **Returned checks will be charged an additional \$25.00.** Full payment must be made within 48 hours to avoid disruption in your child's schedule.

### **REFUNDS**

If a class is not fully enrolled, the class may be cancelled. You will be notified and given a refund, or an alternate class may be chosen. We understand that there may be times when a class is not what your child expected. A full refund will be given if we are notified within 24 hours after the first class. Refunds will not be given if a child misses a class.

### **EARLY RELEASE DAYS**

Regular scheduled classes are **not** held on early release days. A special activity or field trip will be planned. Children must be registered in advance to attend any early release day trips. Use the application form and the DHSP Application to apply for early release days during the scheduled registration days and times.

### **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

Partial scholarships are available. Please request a financial aid form from the director. Income verification in the form of W – 2 or 4 consecutive paystubs must be submitted with the application. All information provided will be kept confidential. **Deadline for financial assistance is Friday, January 9<sup>th</sup>.**

### **CHILD PICK UP & ABSENCES**

Children will only be released to those you have authorized on your child's registration / emergency card. If there are any changes in the pickup arrangements the director must be notified in advance. Only children ages 9 & up will be allowed to walk themselves home with parent/guardian permission. Please notify us by phone or email if your child will be absent from the program.

**TRANSPORTATION**

Community Schools do not provide transportation to after school programming. We cannot meet children at school bus stops. Children ages 9 & up, with parent permission, may ride the bus from another school and walk into the program without adult supervision.

**LATE FEE POLICY**

Instructors are not responsible for children after the class ending time. All children must be promptly picked up at the end of class. There will be a late fee of \$1.00 per minute for each minute you are late after the scheduled pick up time. Late fees must be paid within 48 hours to avoid disrupting your child’s participation in the program. Chronic lateness may result in suspension of your child’s participation in the program. The office clock will be used to determine the time.

**PROGRAM CLOSINGS (Holidays or Snow Days)**

Classes are not held on city holidays, snow days or on days the Cambridge Public Schools are closed.
