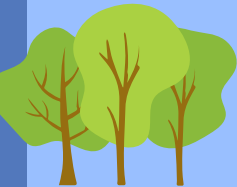

There are over 50 trees planted in Raymond Park and twelve different species including green ash, honeylocust, and serviceberry. The City of Cambridge frequently plants more diverse and resilient trees in Raymond Park, like the dawn redwoods next to the basketball courts.



The community garden in Raymond Park was established in 1976. There are 26 plots where your neighbors grow fruits, vegetables, herbs, and flowers.
