The meeting was called to order at 12:30 p.m.

Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Corr reviewed current Peace Commission projects as described in the annual report, and described in more detail the Police Chaplaincy program and the Cambridge-Haiti Sister City Project.

Ideas for Future Meetings

Corr and members of the Commission discussed ideas for "relaunching" the Peace Commission by clarifying the role of the Commission and its members and focusing on less frequent, but more in-depth meetings that focus on sharing information and supporting community building within the framework of the ordinance that created the Peace Commission. Commission members agreed to meet quarterly.

Upcoming Events

The Peace Commission's annual Martin Luther King Commemoration and Remembrance will take place on January 20, 2014, at St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Cambridge. Larry Kim will offer remarks and Veronique Epiter will perform. Commission members discussed ways to generate press coverage for the event. The Cambridge Haiti Sister City Committee Project will be formally launched on February 4, 2014, at an event in the Central Square Theater. The Annual Commemoration of the Holocaust is tentively scheduled for May 7 or 8, pending final arrangements with a speaker for the event.

Frank Connelly was elected Chair of the Peace Commission by acclamation.
