## Project Details

POAH and Urban Spaces are pleased to share their proposal for the adaptive re-use of the former Sacred Heart Rectory, School, and Convent in East Cambridge. The project will be redeveloped under the Affordable Housing Overlay (AHO) ordinance. Our proposal includes:

- Conversion of the vacant structures into ~46 units of affordable housing
- Creation of new high-quality housing opportunities for Cambridge households and families
- Preservation of the interior and exterior historic character of the buildings and site
