- Potential for modest improvements (e.g., planting, trees, seating) for entry from Winter Street and planted north of courts





- Use our parks and open spaces to make Cambridge more resilient to climate change.




#### **Activating & Enhancing Spaces**

#### What We've Heard So Far

40%

Use the basketball court area regularly

33%

Use the park regularly, but rarely or never use the basketball court area

20%

Pass through the park regularly, but do not often stay and use it

#### Themes:

- Basketball courts need renovation
- Need more seating/picnicking and trees for shading, or add canopy structure
- Consider noise impacts on nearby residences
- Explore multi-sports courts
- Remove unused sports equipment










