- Accessibility improvements across buildings and pathways





An Active Campus All Year Round

- Recent real estate sales reduced parking inventory; currently have 471 in Cambridge
- Shuttle buses run between each campus at 10-15-min. intervals
- Real-time tracking via app
- 358 bicycle racks, repair stand, and tire pumps on each campus
- Coordinating with city on potential new locations for BlueBikes

- Hybrid equipment to position for full electrification
- Divested from direct holdings in fossil fuels in 2015


