Stay for sandwiches, including vegetarian and vegan options, and treats.

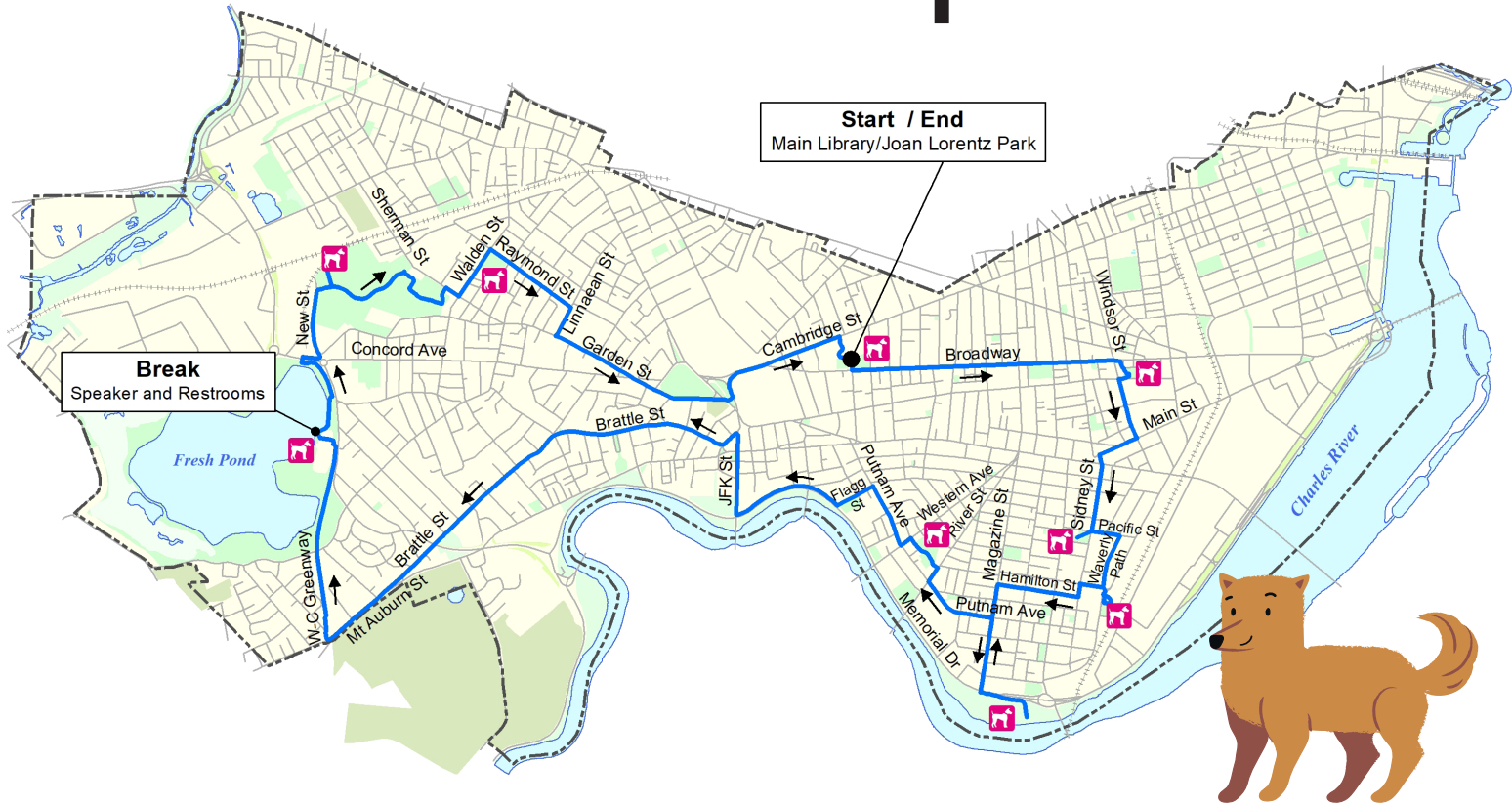
