


Linear Park Bicycle Detour

Cambridge Bicycle Committee Meeting February 12, 2025

These projects are managed by TPT staff

1. Broadway (Portland St to Quincy St)

- Section A (Portland to Columbia) first
- Working Group applications are closed. Group to begin meeting in February
- Recording available soon: Community Meeting 1 was on January 28th, Zoom
- Materials online soon: Open Houses February 4th and 6th

2. Aberdeen Ave

- Design and outreach complete.
- Installation to begin in Spring 2025.

3. Cambridge St (Oak to Second)

- Section A (Oak to Willow) first
 - Feedback survey closed January 31 st.

4. Main St (Central Sq to Portland St)

- Working on final design and public engagement opportunities for Spring 2025
- Installation to begin Spring/Summer 2025

5. Main St (Tech Sq to Albany St)

- Working on final design and developing outreach materials
- Installation to begin Spring/Summer 2025

6. Garden St (Concord Ave to Huron Ave)

Reviewing analysis and implementation options for two-way vehicles in response to Council Order. Report back by April 1, 2025.



DPW Updates

These projects are managed by DPW staff

1. Harvard Square Kiosk Plaza


Continue with plaza re-grading, granite seating and walls, brick replacement, bicycle improvements thru November 2026.

2. River Street

- Utility work continues thru winter
- Begin curb/sidewalk/roadway work in Spring 2025
- Carl Barron Plaza: new bus shelters and "Ribbon" feature begin March 2025
- Magazine/Franklin interim roadway and bike lane changes complete (see additional slides)

3. Mass Ave Partial Construction

- Linnaean-Waterhouse Median Removal begins Spring 2025
 - Pre-construction Open House March 24details and notices coming soon.
- Separated bike lane installation will follow; beginning around mid-2026.
- Concept development for Linnaean-Rindge; and Rindge-Alewife Brook Parkway continues. Public events to occur in 2025 for both segments.

4. Chapter 90 Contracts 24 & 25

- Elm Street (Webster-Hampshire) final paving this spring
- Utility work starts on Maple and Montgomery
- Other streets to follow (Green, Centre, Sciarappa)

5. Chapter 90 Contract 26


- Second round of community meetings: March-May 2025. Bid late Summer 2025
- Streets are Chetwynd, Gray, Haskell, Norfolk, Shepard, Avon Hill, Hillside


6. Port Infrastructure Improvements


- Phase I Utilities/Streets/Sidewalks to begin construction mid-summer 2025 (Multi-year project – more details to come)
- Clement Morgan Park Reconstruction to begin mid-2025


7. Broadway

- Broadway is eastbound only for vehicles between Galileo Way and Ames, with a 2-way bike facility on the south edge.
- This condition will extend to Third Street starting early Spring 2025, and last for around 1 year.
- This supports major utility work associated with the Volpe and Eversource energy projects
