Urban Design Guidelines

- Key qualities: safety and comfort
- No garages at street level
- Greenery
- Comment: what interests me might not interest someone else. Stores are not the only thing of interest why is that they only thing mentioned?
- What about impacts of traffic?
- How can wayfinding be integrated into how places are designed?
 - Spaces should feel friendly and welcoming well designed as such may help people along in their journey, spaces speaks to them
- Nighttime lighting is essential
- Important to consider multimodal connections (e.g., to buses)
