

# Here's What Others Have Said. What Are We Missing?

## **About the Mass Ave Partial Construction Project**

This is a *partial construction* project. This means that the scope of the project includes things like:

- Removal of concrete median
- Crossing islands and pedestrian ramps
- Changes to intersection geometry
- Critical repairs to existing utilities
- Relocation of sections of utilities to improve traffic signal location
- Paving the street and new pavement markings

#### **Porter Square Area Comments**

- Crossing Somerville Ave can be stressful due to length and turning movements
- Sidewalk space constrained
- Wayfinding issues out of the station
- Accessibility issues getting to station entrance
- Shopping Center Parking: Where are lefts permitted?
- Davenport St
  - Vehicles turn left across yellow painted median
  - Crosswalk often blocked by vehicles waiting to turn, pushing bikes out into the intersection

#### Rindge Ave Intersection Comments

- People sometimes cross on side without a crosswalk
- Left bike turns are challenging
- Through bikes don't stop on red and conflict with pedestrians
- Ped crossing of Rindge is not protected—there are frequent conflicts with vehicles turning
- Consider westbound bus stop location on Rindge close to intersection
- Consider curb extension to narrow the crossing distance
- Children cross Mass Ave to get to school

#### **Linear Park Intersection Comments**

- Potential for last block of Cedar St to be one-way
- Two-way on Harvey St works well
- Consider signal timing phasing/coordination
  - Confusion between Cedar St/Cameron Ave
  - Northbound bikes use pedestrian LPI to try to cross diagonally to Linear Park. Design to allow this to happen
- Consider northbound floating bus stop between Cameron Ave and Cedar St

#### **Alewife Brook Parkway Comments**

- Keep median at busy intersection
- Gateway/placemaking needed
- On-street parking needed south of Cottage St at Fast Phils and City Paint store
