### Linear Park Bike Signal



A bike signal, signage, and pavement markings were added to better indicate to bicyclists how to cross Mass Ave.

### Bicycle Parking



Bike parking and fix-it stations were added throughout Cambridge, with 482 bike racks installed between 2016-2018, totalling over 3000.

### Ames Street



The two-way separated bike lane will be extended south of Main St. to Memorial Dr. and a new crossing added, providing better access to the river.

### Vassar at Pacific Crossing



A new pedestrian and bicycle crossing was provided on Vassar St. at the Pacific St. railroad crossing to connect with the eastbound cycletrack.

### Fort Washington Park Path



An access path was paved to provide a crossing to the at-grade railroad tracks.
