Linear Park Bike Signal



A bike signal, signage, and pavement markings were added to better indicate to bicyclists how to

cross Mass Ave.

Fort Washington Park Path




An access path was paved to provide a crossing to the at-grade railroad tracks.

Bicycle Parking



Bike parking and fix-it stations were added throughout Cambridge, with 482 bike racks installed between 2016-2018, totalling over 3000.

Ames Street




The two-way separated bike lane will be extended south of Main St. to Memorial Dr. and a new crossing added, providing better access to the river.

Vassar at Pacific Crossing




A new pedestrian and bicycle crossing was provided on Vassar St. at the Pacific St. railroad crossing to connect with the eastbound cycletrack.

New Bluebikes Stations







Over 20 new bikeshare stations were added since 2016, with 10 more slated for 2019. There are about 270 Bluebikes stations system-wide as of now, with 58 of them in Cambridge.
