MBTA Updates

MBTA Service Restorations

- A schedule change took effect on Sunday, December 19, 2021
 - As the result of lack of bus operators, the MBTA cancelled trips during the Fall schedule in an uncoordinated and unscheduled way.
 - For the winter schedule, the MBTA reduced frequencies on many bus routes.
 - Given the operator shortage, the MBTA stated this should result in improved reliability.
- Routes in Cambridge with reductions in frequency include:
 - Key Bus Routes 1, 66, 77
 - Local Routes: 47, 70, 86, 87, 88
- Route 62 and 76 operate in the AM and PM peak and are combined the rest of the day

MBTA Green Line Extension

- Project is an estimated ~80% complete
- Partial opening planned for March 2022
 - Reopening with service to Lechmere and Union
 - No fare gate line at GLX stations, including Lechmere; stations will have a "fare paid" area
 - Fare vending machines to also serve as fare validation machines
 - Rail-replacement shuttles to remain until service to Lechmere begins
- Service to Medford/Tufts is planned to open in May 2022
- Elevator access for Union station delayed until mid 2022
- 24 new trolleys purchased to accommodate increased ridership
- Train testing has begun between Lechmere and Union


