





Origin of this project is the Cycling Safety Ordinance


This is an area where separated bike lanes are challenging to install with quick-build methods, including:

- frequent buses
- conflicts between buses and cyclists
- conflicts between bus riders and cyclists


Proposing boarding islands as ways to manage these conflicts








#### **Inman Square**


Remaining work is primarily for the new pedestrian plaza, identified in the green area




