## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Planning Board of the City of Cambridge

will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 20, 2023 at 6:30 p.m.

Located at City Hall, 795 Massachusetts Ave., Second Floor, and/or

conducted remotely (see below for instructions to participate)

on a Zoning Petition by by Ian Ferguson et al.,

to amend the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Cambridge by amending Section 5.24.4 "Measurements for minimum yards which are determined by formula" by amending how the denominator in the yard formula is calculated in Section 5.30 for buildings of forty feet or less in height; by amending the language used to determine the average height in a required yard formula for a building with various roof levels in Section 5.24.4.2; and by amending the multi-plane setback formula in Section 5.24.4.3 to account for non-vertical planes and alternative roof shapes. The petition further amends Section 5.24.4 to add a height bulk control plane requirement for Oneand Two-Family buildings over fifty feet in length.
