7:00 p.m. John Chun, et al, (refiled) Zoning Petition to amend the Zoning Map of the City of Cambridge in the entire district currently zoned Residence B located in the Cambridge Highlands neighborhood, situated north of Concord Avenue, south of and adjacent to the Blair Pond Reservation, and east of and adjacent to the municipal boundary with the Town of Belmont by deleting the designation Residence B and substitution therefore a designation of Residence A-2. The lot area per dwelling unit would increase from 2,500 per unit for the first 5,000 square feet of lot area to 4,500 square feet in the Res. A-2 district, the setback requirements would increase and the minimum lot width would increase from 50 feet to 65 feet. The Residence A-2 district does not allow two family dwellings or townhouse dwellings as allowed in the existing Residence B district.
