for a proposal to Construct a new 6-story building to create 71 residential units, 75 long-term, and 13 short-term bicycle parking spaces as well as commercial space in the basement and first floor, with a gross floor area of 64,330 square feet.

The purpose of the advisory consultation is for the Planning Board to comment on the proposal in relation to Section 19.47 of the Cambridge Zoning Ordinance and the City's development guidelines and objectives. This will be the second of two required advisory consultation meetings.
