



### 2023-24 Afterschool Lottery


Update #2

August 31, 2023

- Recognizing how important quality and dependable afterschool care is for Cambridge families, we are committed to providing transparent updates on the 2023-24 Afterschool Programs Lottery.
- Since July 20, we have extended 74 offers to applicants (in addition to making 25 partial offers whole).
- There are still 518 applicants in the waiting pool as of August 28, up from 513 applicants.
- Although there is still unmet demand, we are pleased to show that 76% of applicants, through August 28, have received an offer for afterschool care in the 2023-24 school year, with 90% of those offers receiving their first-choice placement.
- Our afterschool lottery prioritizes low-income applicants. Both income groups—priority and general have high offer rates: 86% for priority applicants and 71% for general applicants.
- Data continues to show that outcomes vary by program, site, and grade due to unique supply and demand conditions.
- For the 2023-2024 school year, we added 170 seats to existing DHSP afterschool programs, and although we still do not have capacity to meet all demand, our expansion work continues:
  - As we committed in May, we have worked in conjunction with the Agenda for Children to support expanded capacity at community-based afterschool programs.
  - There will be an additional 89 seats added across community programs this year as they expand their licenses and add new staff.
  - The City will fund 65 of these seats for low-income families.
- For your reference, we've attached six tables summarizing this year's lottery data, as of August 28, 2023.



## Since July 20, there have been 74 offers from the waiting pool, and we do not expect many placements going forward.



1. A "partial offer" refers to an applicant that was offered fewer days than requested due to site capacity. As seats are declined by other families, partial offers receive priority to match the days requested on their application (or make their offer "whole").



# Placements continue to match applicant preference: 76% received an offer, and 90% of all offers were for first choice placements.




In total, 68% of all applicants received an offer for their first choice.

- 2. Share of offers to the site that were first-choice placements


... And the offer rate is greater than 70% for both applicant income groups.


## Lottery outcomes continue to vary by program, site, and grade due to unique supply and demand conditions.



For example, grade 1-2 at Graham and Parks Community School had a much larger waiting pool than grade 3-5 at Haggerty Community School. For a complete picture of offers, waiting pool size, and capacity at each site, see <u>Table 6 (slides 13-14)</u>.

## Although we cannot currently meet all unmet need, as promised, the City committed to funding additional seats in non-profit programs.

As we committed in May, we have worked in conjunction with the Agenda for Children to support expanded capacity at community-based afterschool programs...
