
Executive Summary

- We know how important quality and dependable afterschool care is for Cambridge children and families, and we are committed to providing transparent updates on DHSP's 2023-24 Afterschool Programs Lottery.
- After making 1,565 initial offers, there were 513 applicants in the waiting pool as of July 20.
- Although there is still unmet demand, we are pleased to show that 75% of applicants, through July 20, have received an offer for afterschool care in the 2023-24 school year, with 91% of those offers receiving their first-choice placement.
- Your experience with the lottery may be different than your friend's or your neighbor's because each program, site, and grade have different supply and demand conditions.
- For the 2023-2024 school year, we added 170 seats to existing DHSP afterschool programs, and although we still do not have capacity to meet all demand, our expansion work continues:
 - As we committed in May, we have worked in conjunction with the Agenda for Children to support expanded capacity at community-based afterschool programs.
 - There will be an additional 89 seats added across community programs this year as they expand their licenses and add new staff.
 - The City will fund 65 of these seats for low-income families.
- For your reference, we've attached six tables summarizing this year's lottery data, as of July 20, 2023.



As of July 20, there were 513 applicants in the waiting pool. We do not expect significant movement from the waiting pool going forward.






Although some applicants will decline their offers, we do not expect more than 50-100 total placements from the waiting pool across all 18 DHSP Afterschool Programs, and offers to the waiting pool are increasingly unlikely after September



After initial placements, 75% of applicants received an offer, and 91% of those offers were for the applicant's first choice placement




In total, 69% of all applicants received an offer for their first choice.

Lottery outcomes may vary because each program, site, and grade has unique supply and demand conditions



For example, on July 20, the JK-K grade at Haggerty Community School had a larger waiting pool than grade 3-5 at the Morse Community School, which had no waiting pool. For a complete picture of offers, waiting pool size, and capacity at each site, see Table 6 (slides 10-11).



Although we cannot currently meet all unmet need, as promised, the City committed to funding additional seats in non-profit programs.

As we committed in May, we have worked in conjunction with the Agenda for Children to support expanded capacity at community-based afterschool programs...

The City will fund 65 of these seats for low-income families.
