WHILE COOKING

- Talk about measurements and have your child help. "We need three cups. We just put in the first one. How many more do we need?"
- Compare sizes of measuring cups.

WHILE DOING LAUNDRY

- Count articles of clothing or buttons.
- Sort laundry by color or another category.
- Talk about sizes and make comparisons.
- Measure the laundry detergent.

DURING BEDTIME

- Count fingers up to ten.
- Read books with numbers in them.
- Search for numbers, shapes and patterns in the books that you read.



WHILE YOU ARE BUSY

- Give your child objects to sort: Mixed cereals, toys, crayons, cups, bowls, or containers.
- When the child finishes sorting, ask them how they sorted or have them count the objects.
