Schedule Update: Installation in 2024

Nearby Project Updates

Bike Lanes between Portland Street and Albany Street

In October, the Ragon Institute will begin installing separated bike lanes on Main Street between Portland Street and Albany Street as part of their ongoing construction project.

The Port Infrastructure Improvements Project

The Port Infrastructure Improvements Project will replace water, sewer, and drain lines in much of The Port neighborhood north of Main Street.
