Separated Bike Lanes Coming to Main Street; Parking Will Be Reduced

What is Happening?

The City of Cambridge is adding separated bike lanes and making other safety improvements to Main Street between Mass Ave and Portland Street, including the street in front of Newtowne Court.

To do this, we will have to remove over half of the parking on this section of Main Street.

On other streets where we've installed separated bike lanes, average car speeds have gone down. This makes the street safer for everyone.
